Status Key: **A** has been collected since 1999. **A1** and **A2** were no longer collected on the undergraduate application starting in 2010 (A1 was replaced by two categories: Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander; A2 was replaced by the two categories of Asian Indian and Pakistani). **A3** is represented as "White/Caucasian" in graduate data collection and undergraduate data collection pre-2010, and as "European/European Descent" in undergraduate data collection post 2010. "Other White" was added in 2010. **B** has been collected on the undergraduate application since 2010, with varying dates of adoption among graduate programs. The **B1** categories were removed from the undergraduate collection in 2014 in favor of more detailed categories. **C** has been collected on the undergraduate application since 2014.
