## CAMPUS STUDENT AND EMPLOYEE POPULATIONS HIGHLIGHTS

as of 19 October 2004

### TOTAL CAMPUS

(Registered student and employee information is current as of 19 October 2004.)

- In total, there are 40,230 people employed by or attending classes at UCSD.
- Of these, 7,500 students, faculty and staff live in University City and La Jolla.
- Further, three-fourths of students and employees live within 10 miles of campus (excluding those who work at off-campus sites).

### STUDENTS

(These data are based on those for whom address and age information were available.)

- In Fall 2004, there were 25,100 students registered on campus.
- Women and men students are equally represented on campus--50% women and 50% men.
- Overall, 37% of students live in campus housing; another 5% list a campus department as their current mailing address.
- Three-fourths of all students (including those who live on campus) live less than 5 miles from campus.
- Thirty percent of all students live in either University City or La Jolla.

### EMPLOYEES

(Emeriti faculty and other employees on recall status are included; student workers are excluded.)

- In October 2004, UCSD employed 15,100 people.
- Two-thirds of all campus employees work in the campus areas of Scripps Institution of Oceanography, Torrey Pines Center, the VA hospital, West Campus and East Campus.
- About 4,700 UCSD employees work at off-campus sites at Hillcrest, Point Loma and other areas.
- Fifteen percent of campus employees live in either University City or La Jolla.
- Nearly 60% of all campus employees who work at main campus or at the VA hospital live within 10 miles of their job locations.
