

## University of California, San Diego Campus Population Overview, October 2005

### **Campus Population--Students, Faculty, and Staff**

- In total, there are 43,287 people employed by or attending classes at UCSD in October 2005 (Table 1).
- 73% (23,572) of all students, faculty, and staff for whom address information is available live within 10 miles of the campus or their work sites (Table 2).
- 76% (25,323) of the campus population for whom address information is available live in the City of San Diego (Table 3).
- 50% (16,704) of students, faculty, and staff for whom current address information is available live on campus or in the nearby communities of University City, La Jolla, Mira Mesa, and North Clairemont. The remainder reside in other areas of San Diego County as well as adjacent counties (Table 4).

### **Students**

(Student residential information is based on those for whom current address information in San Diego County is available.)

- In Fall 2005, there were 25,673 registered students, excluding health science residents (Table 5) . This is a growth of 2% (537) over the previous fall.
- Women students slightly out number men--51% (12,987) women to 49% (12,686) men (Table 5).
- 77% (12,385) of all students for whom current address information is available live in campus housing, University City, La Jolla, or Mira Mesa (Table 6).
- 78% (12,561) of all students for whom current address information was available live within 5 miles from campus including those who live on campus (Table 7).

### **Faculty and Staff**

(Emeriti faculty and other employees on recall status are included; student workers are excluded.)

- In October 2005, UCSD employed 17,614 people (Table 8).
- 64% (11,278) of those employed by UCSD work in the La Jolla campus areas at Scripps Institution of Oceanography, Torrey Pines Center, School of Medicine, Skaggs School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences, the VA Hospital, West Campus and East Campus (Table 8).
- An additional 28% (4,928) workers are employed in the Hillcrest Medical Center area (Table 8).
- The remainder, 8% or 1,408 people, work in Point Loma, elsewhere in the County, or at other off-campus research sites (Table 8).
- Women make up a slight majority (56% or 9,943) of all campus employees (Tables 8 and 9).
- 26% (4,607) of campus workers are employed in academic positions (Table 10)
- 57% (6,275) of all campus employees who work at main campus or at the VA hospital live within 10 miles of their job locations (Table 11).
- And 58% (2,840) of those working at Hillcrest live within 10 miles of their job locations (Table 12).
- 60% (10,554) of all campus employees for whom address information is available live in the City of San Diego (Table 13).
- 35% (6,108) of all campus employees for whom home address information is available live in 7 San Diego areas--University City, La Jolla, Chula Vista, Mira Mesa, Carmel Valley, Mission Hills, or North Clairemont (Table 14).
