In Fall 1960, the San Diego campus was approved by the Regents of the University of California as a degree-granting institution. Prior to that time graduate students in Scripps Institution of Oceanography were awarded degrees through either UCLA or UC Berkeley.
Health science graduate academics as well as medical and pharmacy residents (house staff) have been included in the Health Sciences category.
Beginning Fall 2002, students in the Skaggs School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences are included with School of Medicine enrollments.
General Campus student counts include students at Scripps Institution of Oceanography.
Postbaccalaureate Teaching Credential, offered through the Department of Education Studies, was discontinued in 2001
Self-supporting includes: MAS programs (General Campus and Health Sciences) and Rady School of Management.
