**Campus Population Overview, October 2010**

***Campus Population--Students, Faculty, and Staff***

- In total, there were 48,799 people employed by or attending classes at UCSD in October, 2010 ([Table 1](#)).

***Students***

- In fall 2010, there were 29,176 registered students, excluding health science residents ([Table 2](#)). This is a 2.7% increase from the previous fall.
- 81% (23,663) of all students are undergraduate students, the rest are graduate, medical, or pharmacy students ([Table 2](#)).

***Faculty and Staff***

(Emeriti faculty and other employees on recall status are included; student workers are excluded.)

- In October, 2010, UCSD employed 19,623 people ([Table 3](#)).
- 65% (12,748) of those employed by UCSD work in the La Jolla campus areas, which include East Campus, Salk Institute, Scripps Institution of Oceanography, School of Medicine, the VA Hospital, and West Campus ([Table 3](#)).
- An additional 27% (5,193) work at the Hillcrest Medical Center area ([Table 3](#)).
- 27% (5,281) of all campus employees are employed in academic positions ([Table 3](#)).
- Of the employees working at the La Jolla campus or the VA Hospital, 26% (3,354) live within 5 miles of their job locations and 80% (10,157) live within 15 miles of their job locations ([Table 4](#)).
- 43% (2,761) of those working at Hillcrest live within 10 miles of their job location ([Table 5](#)).
- 63% (12,323) of all employees live within the City of San Diego ([Table 6](#)).
- 38% (7,390) of all employees for whom address information is available live in seven San Diego areas: University City, La Jolla, Chula Vista, Carmel Valley, Mission Hills, Mira Mesa, and North Clairemont ([Table 7](#)).
