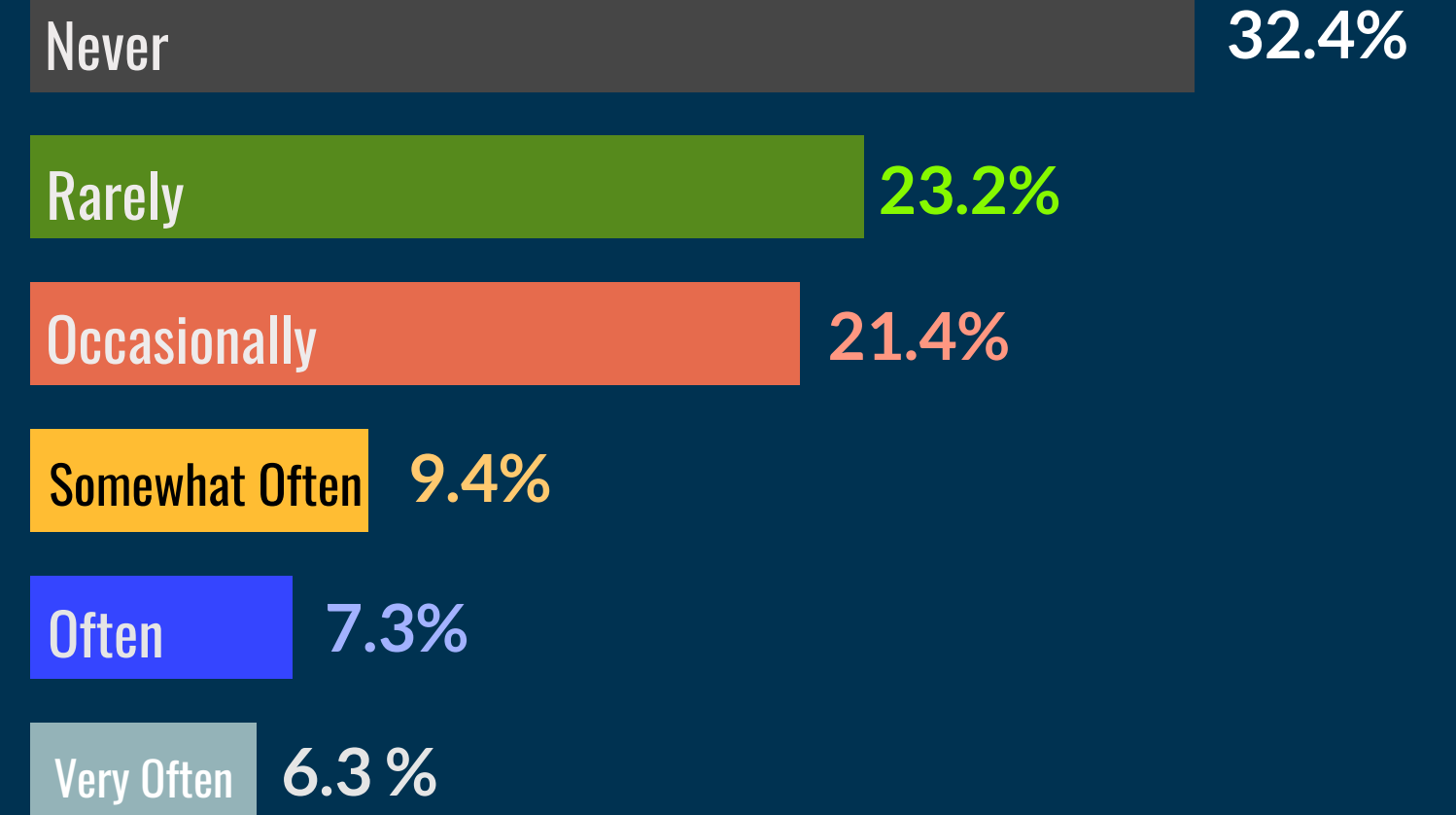

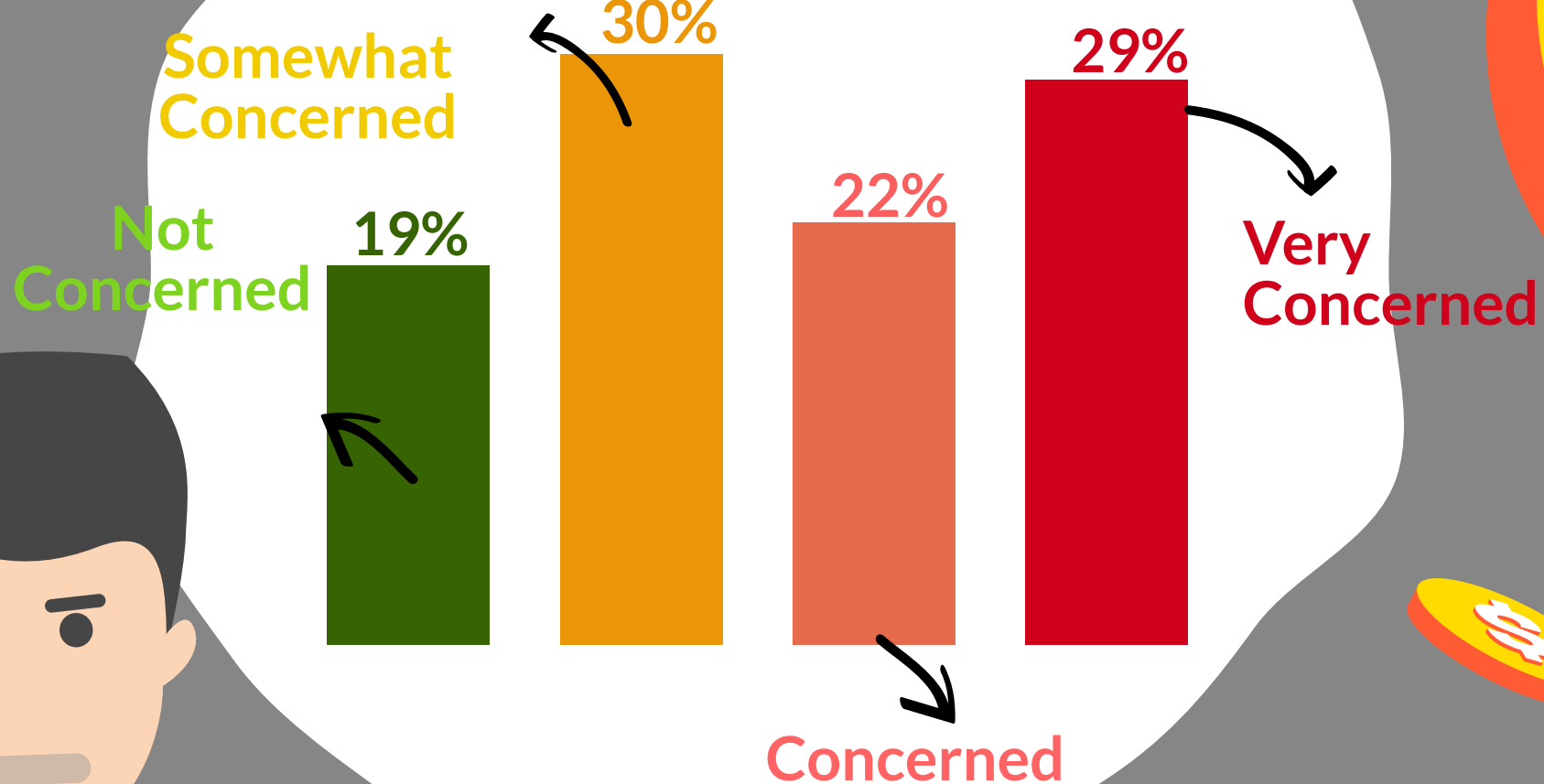

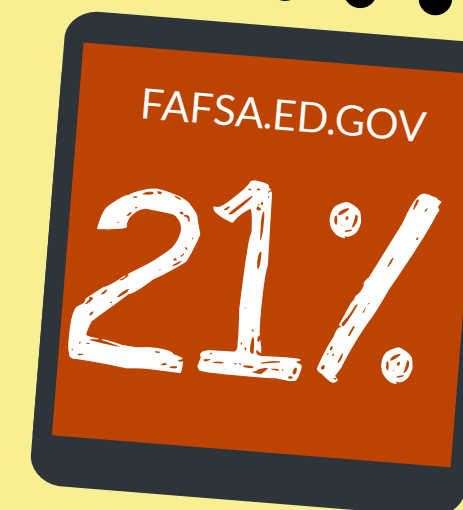
Skipped or cut the size of meals because there wasn't enough money for food.
